RISK ASSESSMENT

WHAT IS RISK ASSESSMENT?

A Risk Assessment is a careful examination of what in the workplace could cause harm to people and an evaluation of whether precautions in place are adequate for minimizing risks.

The Health and Safety at Work Act (1974) and the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations (1999) place duties on companies and individuals to ensure that adequate provisions are made for health and safety at work.

- Is the basis of successful safety and health management.
- Is the key to reducing work related accidents and occupational diseases.
- Can improve workplace safety and health and business performance.

WHY IS RISK ASSESSMENT IMPORTANT?

Risk Assessment are an important procedure in protecting employees and the organization. Accidents and illness can have detrimental impact. This can be through loss of productivity, damage, bad reputation, increased insurance cost, etc.

Employers can carry out risk assessments internally, provided there is an understanding of what is required and the general principals. Involving staff in the process helps collate useful information on how work can be done with minimum risks. This will make the assessment of the risks more thorough and effective.

WHO IS RESPONSIBLE?

Employers are required by law to carry out a risk assessment. (Undang-Undang RI No. 1 tahun 1970)
