# KEBAYA GOES TO UNESCO

A kebaya is an upper garment traditionally worn by women in Southeast Asia, notably in Indonesia, Malaysia, Brunei, and Singapore. It is officially recognized as the national costume of Indonesia, and its fashion icon, although it is more popularly worn by Javanese, Sundanese and Balinese people. While in Malaysia, Singapore and Brunei, it is recognized as one of its ethnic costumes especially among Peranakan communities, the complete outfit is known in these region as "sarong kebaya" which its style is vary from place to place throughout the region.



Kebaya has become South East Asian fashion icon and surprisingly today, it has been more and more popular that women in Indonesia has start to wear kebaya as their daily look through the #SelasaBerkebaya movement.

Recently, kebaya has been submitted as an Intangible Cultural Heritage to UNESCO, a special agency of the United Nations, which is engaged in education, science and culture. This means that kebaya will follow Batik, a traditional Indonesian outfit that has received recognition from UNESCO since October 2, 2009.

The hashtag Kebaya Goes To UNESCO is now being echoed. And not only in Indonesia, the support from abroad for #KebayaGoesToUNESCO was also pouring in. Around 200 women in Washington DC. enlivened the "Cantik Berkebaya" parade in the National Mall area on August 7, 2022.

# NEW PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

Pedestrian crossings are generally placed on busy roads, their function being both to assist pedestrians to cross roads and to do so with greater safety.

Pedestrian crossings are often found at intersections, but may also be at other points on busy roads that would otherwise be too



unsafe to cross without assistance. They are also commonly installed where large numbers of pedestrians are attempting to cross or where vulnerable road users regularly cross. Rules govern usage of pedestrian must be more than halfway across the crosswalk before the driver proceeds.

Capital Place Estate Management recently installed a new pedestrian crossing to facilitate pedestrians who will cross from the Komunal drop off to the Smoking Area. We encourage everyone to use this new pedestrian crossing.
