FIRE SAFETY & EVACUATION AWARENESS

Fire incidents can occur unexpectedly and spread rapidly, especially in high-rise buildings. While fire protection systems and emergency procedures are in place, their effectiveness depends on how well occupants understand and respond to them.

Fire safety is not only about preventing fires—it is also about knowing how to react calmly and safely when an emergency occurs. Being prepared can help protect lives, reduce injuries, and support an orderly evacuation.

Fire Safety Starts with Prevention

Many workplace fires are preventable and often result from unsafe practices or overlooked hazards. Employees can help reduce fire risks by:

- Keeping work areas clean and free from unnecessary combustible materials.
- Using electrical equipment properly and reporting damaged cords, plugs, or devices.
- Avoiding overloaded power outlets and unauthorized electrical modifications.
- Keeping fire exits, fire extinguishers, and fire safety equipment accessible at all times.
- Following building policies regarding smoking and the use of heat-generating devices.

Simple preventive actions can significantly reduce the likelihood of a fire incident.

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Safe Evacuation Practices

An effective evacuation depends on awareness and cooperation from all building occupants.

Remember to:

- Familiarize yourself with the nearest emergency exits from your workplace.
- Know the location of the designated assembly point.
- Follow evacuation signage and instructions.
- Stay together with your team when possible.
- Never re-enter the building until an official "All Clear" announcement has been given.

Participating actively in fire drills helps build confidence and ensures that everyone understands the proper evacuation procedures.
