# *INDONESIA'S FIRST MASS RAPID TRANSIT (MRT)*

The Jakarta's Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) was officially opened on 24 March 2019. The first phase of Jakarta MRT connects Bundaran Hotel Indonesia in Central Jakarta and Lebak Bulus in South Jakarta. Covering 15.7 km distance in under 30 minutes, it comprises seven elevated stations and six underground stations. To use this facility, you may purchase a card called "Jelajah". The ticket price of Jakarta MRT has been finally agreed (maximum fare at Rp 14,000) with the boarding fee of IDR 1.500. During April, they will be operating from 5.30 AM - 10.30 PM everyday. After that, they will start the normal operational hour from 5 AM - 12 AM.



# *SIX PLACES TO VISIT WITH MRT*

## **1. Museum Basoeki Abdullah**

You may tap out in Fatmawati Station to visit this museum. In this place, you may see the beautiful art of this maestro collections and some of his private collections.

## **2. Taman Ayodya**

Still in Fatmawati area, you should visit this park. Strolling around, a gazebo that can be used for relaxing, jogging track for exercise with water fountain that would be great for your photo spot.

## **3. Little Tokyo**

Around Blok M Station, there is a place called "Little Tokyo". Enjoy the taste of Japanese food with beautiful decoration and ornament that you may find as Instagrammable.

## **4. Gelora Bung Karno**

Stop at Istora Station and you would find this place easily since this place is one of the iconic place in Jakarta. This place has been used by many of big event and concert in town such as Asean Games 2018. You could also use their jogging track with your family and friends.

## **5. Wisata Kuliner Bendungan Hilir (Benhil)**

Pamper your taste buds with many of traditional items that you may find in Benhil area. From mie Aceh, dimsum, seafood, satai, and various choices of traditional snacks.

## **6. Bundaran Hotel Indonesia**

This place was surrounded by malls, couples of fine hotel and there is also a Welcome Monument in here. This monument was built during the President Soekarno administration, to welcome the delegates of the Asian Games IV in 1960. In 2002, this place was restored with new fountains, new design of the pool, and new lighting. Nowadays, this spot also become a popular spot for their spectacular view at the evening because of the water fountain that beautifully captured with the lovely lighting .
