THE HISTORY OF **INDONESIA** INDEPENDENCE DAY

Indonesia became independent on August 17, 1945, after previously being under both Dutch and Japanese colonialism.

The Proclamation of Indonesian Independence was read by Soekarno, accompanied by Mohammad Hatta, at Jalan Pegangsaan Timur 56, Central Jakarta.

On August 6, 1945, the city of Hiroshima, Japan, was devastated by the atomic bomb dropped by the United States. Three days later, an atomic bomb attack on Nagasaki City, Japan occurred. In just a short time, these two atomic bombs succeeded in killing hundreds of thousands of people in Hiroshima and Nagasaki. As a result, Japan, which had been badly defeated, and was forced to surrender, which also marked the end of World War II.

The Japanese tried to prevent news of their defeat from being heard by the Indonesian people, but to no avail. The young groups immediately urged Soekarno and Hatta to declare Indonesian independence. But Sukarno was reluctant, and chose to wait for an agreement from the Preparatory Committee for Indonesian Independence (PPKI).



Not wanting to be further intimidated by the Japanese, a youth group decided to kidnap the two Indonesian national figures in the early hours of 16 August 1945 at Rengasdengklok, Karawang. The two of them continued to be pressed until finally, Soekarno and Hatta agreed to proclaim Indonesian independence no later than August 17, 1945.

Soekarno and Hatta were brought back to Jakarta, and to the home of Rear Admiral Tadasi Maeda, Chief of Navy and Army Liaison Officer for the Imperial Japanese Army. It was in this house that Soekarno, Hatta, and Achmad Soebardjo drafted the proclamation.

After long negotiations, the text of the proclamation was finally completed and read in front of all the Indonesian people on August 17, 1945. On the same day, the Sang Saka

Merah Putih flag was raised, which had been sewn by Soekarno's wife, Fatmawati.

After this thrilling moment, Indonesia officially got its independence. Soekarno was elected as President of Indonesia and Mohammad Hatta as Vice President.

MONAS

The National Monument (Monas) Park in Central Jakarta is home to Ikada Square, where thousands of people flocked on Sept. 19, 1945, to hear president Sukarno's speech. The big meeting was organized by young members of the Komite Van Aksi (Committee of Action) to celebrate a month after the Proclamation of the Independence. The area of Ikada Square was turned into Monas, where Sukarno built the iconic monument in 1961. The monument was built to remember the struggle of Indonesians who fought against colonialism.

FIRE EXTINGUISHER

Fire Extinguishers are effective only when fires are in the first stages. It is of great importance that they be immediately accessible and promptly used. They are the first line of fire defence and never a substitute for automatic sprinklers, which are the main line of defence.

Fire Extinguisher Classes divided into:

Class A

Fire extinguishers are used for ordinary combustibles such as wood, paper, some plastics and textiles. This fire class requires the heatabsorbing effects of water or the coating effects of certain dry chemicals.



Class B

Fire extinguishers are used for flammable liquid and gas fires such as oil, gasoline, etc. These fire extinguishers deprive the fire of oxygen and interrupt the fire chain by inhibiting the release of combustible vapours.



Class C

Fire extinguishers are used on fires that involve live electrical equipment that require the use of electrically nonconductive extinguishing agents. Once the electrical equipment is deenergized, extinguishers for Class A or B fires may be used.



Class D

Fire extinguishers are used on combustible metals such as magnesium, titanium, sodium, etc., which require an extinguishing medium that does not react with the burning metal.



Class K

Fire extinguishers are used on fires involving cooking media (fats, grease and oils) in commercial kitchens. Due to the higher heating rates of vegetable oils in commercial cooking appliances, the NFPA Standard for Portable Fire Extinguishers (NFPA 10) includes a Class K extinguisher. These fire extinguishers work on the principle of saponification, which takes place when alkaline mixtures such as potassium acetate, potassium citrate or potassium carbonate are applied to burning cooking oil or fat.

Nasi Goreng Tiwul



In the colonial era, Indonesians were forced to hand over their food products to the colonizers. With this system, the people of Indonesia, especially on the island of Java experienced food shortages.

Tiwul fried rice or nasi goreng tiwul is one of the processed foods in the form of rice mixed with tiwul and some simple spices to complement the taste. Until now, food menus that are reminiscent of the colonial period have become foods that are much-loved by society.

Nasi Jagung - Madura Corn rice is a processed food made from rice

and corn. Corn is easy to find in Indonesia and often being used as snacks. While rice is more difficult to find, thus the

people of Madura make corn as a foodstuff mixed with rice. Foods that contain this source of protein-energy became the food of the fighters in the land of Madura in the past.



Tumpeng Merah Putih – Java



The red and white yellow rice in a cone shape is often being served as one of the traditional foods to celebrate independence day. Generally, tumpeng rice is yellow in color, but people make it red and white to symbolize the Indonesian flag during the national day.

Perkedel Jagung – North Sulawesi
